PAMPLONA, SPAIN



UC Berkeley students now have the incredible opportunity to do short-term study abroad (3 weeks) during the summer in beautiful Northern Spain, through the UC Berkeley Sociology Department's new partnership with the University of Navarra, in Pamplona, Spain. Pamplona is located in the Basque region of Spain, and is known for its unique culinary cuisine, wine region, "Running of the Bulls" festival in July, and the famous Camino de Santiago pilgrimage which goes right through town and the university campus. It is only about 1 ½ hours from the Atlantic coast and the south of France. This is a brand new program and we're still figuring out the details on our end for the Sociology sponsorship, and will do so by early March. We are looking into the possibility of providing a tuition waiver. The primary course that is offered in the 3-week session Spanish Language and Culture (multiple levels), has been reviewed and approved for transfer to UC Berkeley as long as the course is taken at a level that is higher than what a student has taken at UC Berkeley. Students should confirm with their department and/or college about transferability of a course for specific requirements. We will provide you with the syllabus at the information session. There are other programs at the University of Navarra to extend the study abroad experience that students may choose to do on their own (see brochure).

The deadline to apply to the University of Navarra summer program is coming up quickly, March 16th, and we will have an earlier deadline to apply internally at the Sociology Department by February 28th. So now is the time to think through this opportunity and explore the University of Navarra website (www.unav.edu/ilce) for more information.
