

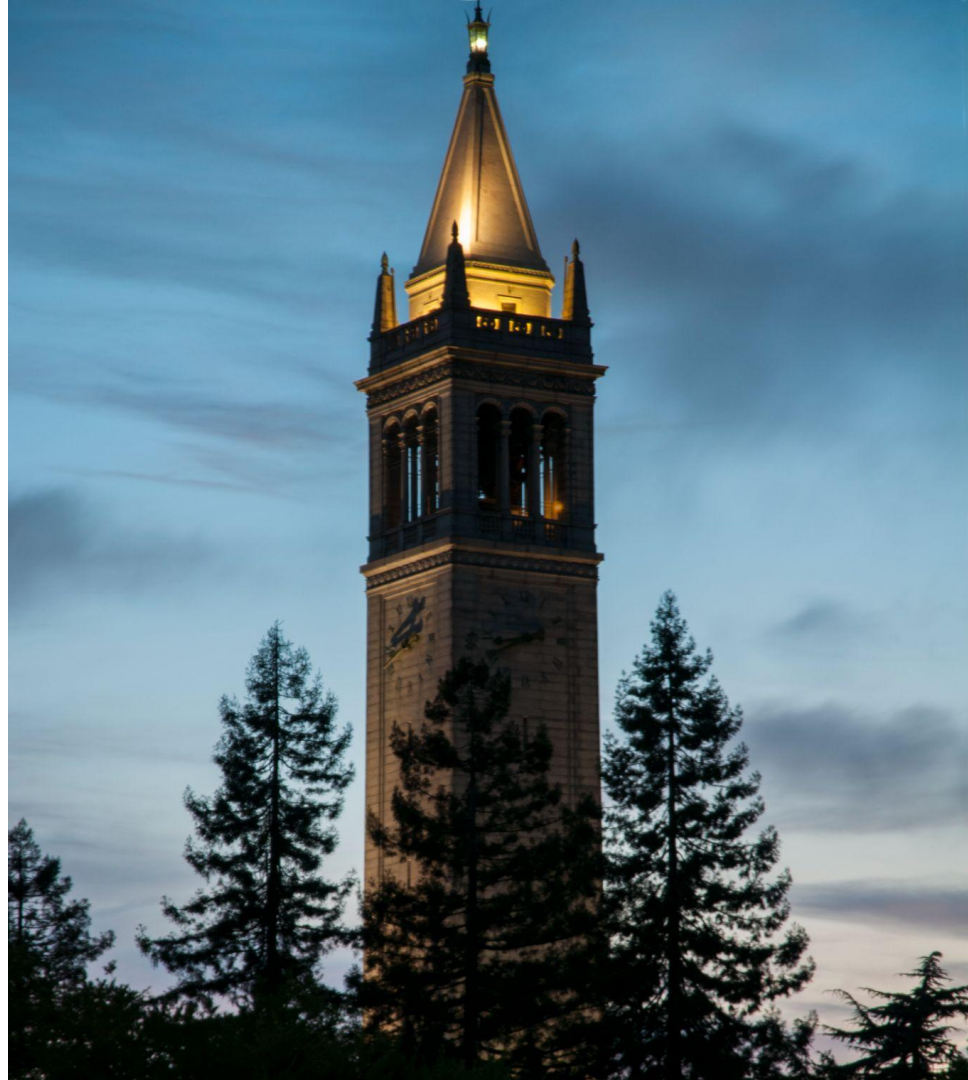

SOC 190 Exception Request

- Complete AT LEAST ONE Sociology research methods elective PRIOR to taking the seminar requirement.
- Speak with your seminar instructor about pursuing the Research Methods Concentration and about your proposed research project.
- The final research paper or project for the Sociology Seminar must use the same methodology taught in your COMPLETED research methods course.
- Students will receive a notification if their SOC 190 research project is approved

Professors will also be notified that you are pursuing the Concentration.

They will also be asked to confirm the project was completed at the end of the semester.
